

# MADISON 56ERS SPRING CUP AND FALL INVITATIONAL TOURNAMENT RULES: COVID ADDENDUM

## 1. Local Public Health Orders

In addition to these tournament rules, all events offered at the Madison 56ers Spring Cup are subject to the public health orders issued by their respective local jurisdictions at the time of events. To the extent that local public health orders are more restrictive than tournament rules, the public health orders shall be followed.

Events held at the Woodside Soccer Complex (Dells and Mauston facilities) are subject to public health orders issued by the Adams County Health & Human Services Department.

Events held in Dane County, if any, are subject to orders issued by Public Health Madison & Dane County. Players, coaches, team officials, game officials, tournament staff, spectators, and anyone else in attendance (collectively "Participants") are required to follow all local public health orders and tournament rules at all times.

## 2. Face Coverings

All Participants are required to wear face coverings at all times. Face coverings must simultaneously cover the nose and mouth and they must remain in place while within the grounds of the tournament. The only exception to this face coverings requirement will be for players actively participating in a match, who are not required, but are permitted, to wear face covering. However, players shall wear face covering during warm up and while on sidelines during game competition.

Face covering requirements shall be enforced at all times, regardless of one's vaccination status so as to provide for the greatest level of protection for all participants.

## 3. Social Distancing

Social distancing shall be maintained to the greatest extent possible throughout the grounds of the tournament. Participants on the sidelines shall maintain

distance to the greatest extent permitted. Participants shall locate on the sidelines across from their team during the game and shall vacate the sideline area promptly following the conclusion of the match so as to allow for safe and orderly transition for the preceding match. In order to allow for the greatest amount of distancing, we ask that teams limit the Participant fans to the greatest extent possible, and no more than 2 per player whenever possible.

## 4. Enforcement

Individuals' vaccination status or personal beliefs as to face coverings and distancing shall not impact adherence to the COVID rules addendum. If you are unwilling to abide by the rules intended to provide safety and peace of mind for all Participant, you are asked to not attend. The Tournament Director, not game officials, shall have full enforcement authority as to these COVID rules and expectations. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE REASONABLE EXPECTATIONS WILL RESULT IN ENFORCEMENT, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO: EXPULSION OF PARTICIPANTS OR POSTPONEMENT, SHORTENING OR CANCELLING OF MATCHES.
